

give sufficient security to make satisfaction to the said Orphan or Orphans when at age as aforesaid and upon refusal thereof as the said Orphan or Orphans if at age to choose his her or their Guardian shall do it and if not then such other as the said Commission shall think most convenient to take the same who shall enjoy the said land or plantation (committing) no waste and performing all such matters and things at his entry thereupon as is by this Act Required until the said Orphan come to age and the said person so chosen or by the Justice in possession as aforesaid shall in the name and to the use of such Orphan bring his action of waste against the former Guardian for the damage by him committed, And be it further enacted that all matters and things contained in the Act for the better Administration of Justice in probate of wills Granting Administrations recovery of Legacies and pursuing filiall portions and in this Law for the preservation of Orphans real Estates be by the Commission of every County Court in this Province so often as the grand Jury shall there be summoned give the same in charge to them and shall also every June Court yearly and in every year hold a Court according to Act of Assembly solely and wholly to put in Execution the matters and things in this Law and the said Law for better Administration of Justice in probate of wills and granting Letters of Administration Recovery of Legacies and pursuing filiall portions contained upon the penalty of five hundred pounds of Tobacco each Justice the one half thereof to their said Majesty's their heirs and successors for the support of this Government the other half to him or them that shall sue for the same to be recovered in the Provinceall Court by Bill plaint or Information wherein no Staye protection or wayer of Law shall be allowed
