 same. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that whosoeuer
 after the passing of this Act malitiously and advisedly by writinge speaching
 or otherwise ex press publick utter or declare any wordes sentencē or other
 thing or things to the Defaming or scandall of their Majesties Governoour or
 Comandeē in chifē for the tyme being and therof to gally convicē shall be
 Imprisoned six moneths without bayle or mainprise and incur such forfature
 as the Justices before whom such matter is tryed shall adju dge not exceeding
 the sume of ten Thousand pounds of tobacco to our sovereign Lord and
 Lady the King and Queen their heirs and successors for the supporte of
 government, And be it further Enacted that whosoeuer shall malitiously
 and advisedly by writinge speaching or otherwise ex press publick utter or
 declare any wordes sentencē or other thing to the scandall of their Majesties
 Councellours Judges and Justices or other principall Officers in relation to their
 severall Office or Officer as aforesaid being therof gally Convicē shall
 be Imprisoned during thred moneths without bayle or mainprise and
 incur such fynd and forfature as the Justices before whom such matter
 is tryed shall adju dge not exceeding the sume of five Thousand pounds of
 tobacco to our sovereign Lord and Lady the King and Queen their heirs
 or successors for the supporte of the Government Any Act or order to the
 Contrarie notwithstanding.

 Whereas nothing can contribute more to the speedy settling and peopling
 of this their Majesties Province of Maryland but that all possible encouragement
 should be given to persons of different nations to transport themselves
 with their families and stock. Be it therefore Enacted by the King and
 Queens most Excellent Majesties with the advice and consent of this pre
 sident General Assembly and by the Authority of the same That
 It shall be Lawfull for the present Governoour of this Province to issue
