

Minister inducted into the same, But if no Minister be Inducted into  
the Parrish, then the same Tobacco or such part thereof as by the said  
vestry men shall be thought convenient to be kept and made use of  
for the necessary reparations of the Church or chappell aforesaid  
or other pious uses at the discretion of the vestry men aforesaid. And  
to the end that any gift <sup>Grant</sup> bequest, <sup>Grant</sup> or appointment by any  
person or persons which shall be so piously inclined either by their  
last Wills and Testaments or by Deeds executed in their life time to give  
grant or in any ways appoint or bestow any sum or sums of Money  
Tobacco Goods or Chattells Lands Tenements or hereditaments of  
what nature or kind soever for the use and benefit of any Minister  
or Ministers or to the Ministry or Par of any Parrish or Parrishes  
within this Province, the vestrymen for the same Parrish by their  
Act are Impowered and Authorized to take the same into their  
Custody and Possession and apply to the use and intent of the Donor or  
Donors. And the better to enable them to recover and receive the  
same, they are hereby fully and absolutely Impowered Authorized  
and Qualified to prosecute and Maintain any Action or Actions  
what soever, whether real personall or mixt for the Recovery  
of all or any the premises aforesaid from any Person or Persons  
that shall hold or detaine any of the goods or chattles Tenements  
or hereditaments as aforesaid, given and granted & otherwise  
app<sup>d</sup> to the uses aforesaid, or for any damages accruing by any  
Trespast upon and in the premises or any of them, and in the  
Prosecution of any Action or Actions as aforesaid to prosecute and
