

taking out his or their dispatches or dispatches for every such respective
ship or vessell and before the departure of such ship or vessell from the
Province, and that every master of such ship or vessell coming into the
Province shall at their first arrivall here and before their loading on
board any goods or commodities of the growth production & manu-
facture of the Province, give good and sufficient security to his or her
or to the officer thereunto especially appointed for the payment
of the said duty or imposition accordingly. **Provided** always
and it is the true intent and meaning hereof that this Act nor any
thing herein contayned, shall be adjudged construed reputed or taken
to disannull or make void his Lordships Right to the other moiety
of the said two shillings $\text{p}^{\text{t}} \text{t}^{\text{h}}$ to be paid in consideration of his
Rents and alienation money in Tobacco at proportion p^{r} pound
during the terme of his naturall life (and that the same be kept &
hereby preserved to his Lordship in as full and ample manner as
by the said Law is exprest or intended or in y^e least to discharge his do^t
for receiving the Rents aforesaid at $\frac{1}{2}$ p^{t} as by the said Act is enjoyned
during also y^e terme of his naturall life nor to discharge his Lordship
from accounting for y^e arr^{ts} of some p^{r} p^{r} for supporting of y^e Gov^{mt}
and financing Armes & Ammunition, but y^e he be obliged to all y^e matt^{rs} & things as
fully and strongly as if the said Law were in full force. **And**
it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that every Master
of a ship or vessell as aforesaid at the time of his clearing, shall
upon oath declare the quality and quantity of his loading, and
that the Navall Officer by the Governor aforesaid for the time
