Whereas many and frequent Complaints have been
made by divers good People of this Province, who of late Years ~
have procured of the Lord Proprietary of this Province, warrants
for the laying out Land taking up severall quantites of Land ~
within the same, and have past their Bond to his Ex: according
John Cale, Conditions of Plantations for the same and by virtue
of their Warrants the severall Surveyors of this Province had before
the Revolution of affairs within the same surveyed and laid
out pursuant to the said Warrants severall tracts and parcels of
Land for them or to their assigns, and either had returned the
Certificates
