AN ACT for securing the Rights of Several Persons,

Whereas many and frequent Complaints have been
made by divers good People of this Province, who of late Years
have procured of the Lord Proprietary of this Province, warrants
for the laying out and taking up severall quantities of Land
within the same, and have past their Bond to his Lo.^{ty} according
to his late Conditions of Plantations for the same and by vertue
of their warrants the severall Surveyors of this Province had before
the Revolution of affairs within the same, surveyed and laid
out pursuant to the said Warrants severall Tracts and parcells of
Land for them or to their Assigns, and either had returned the
Certificate
