Provided this Act nor anything herein contained Repeal or be Con-
strued to Repeal an Act made at the Generall Assembly the Thirteenth
day of Aprill one thousand six hundred seaveny four, Intituled an Act
concerning Servants that have Runawayes, And for Encouragement
of our Neighboring Colonies of Virginia Delaware and the Northern
parts of America for the taking up of Servants and Runawayes
out of this Province into those Parts Be it further enacted
by the advice Consent and Authority aforesaid That the sum
of four hundred pounds of Tobacco Shall from henceforth be al-
lowed and paid to any Person in these Colonies of Virginia Dela-
ware and the Northern parts of America that shall be seized
or take up such Servants or others runawayes and carry and
cause them to be carried before some Magistrate of any County
of this Province upon whose Certificate of Delivering of such
Servants Runawayes the said sum of four hundred pounds of
Tobacco to be paid or secured to be paid by the Master Mistress
or Deme to whom such Servant shall of right belong or apper-
tene, And the said Servant to remeber the said Master
Mistress Deme or owner by Servitude or otherwise to the full
satisfaction and content of the said Master Mistress Deme or
owner But if the runawaye so taken up and delivered by the
Magistrate as aforesaid be a free man, Then such Runawaye to
be Imprisoned till such time as he hath made satisfaction of
said sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco or shall give good
