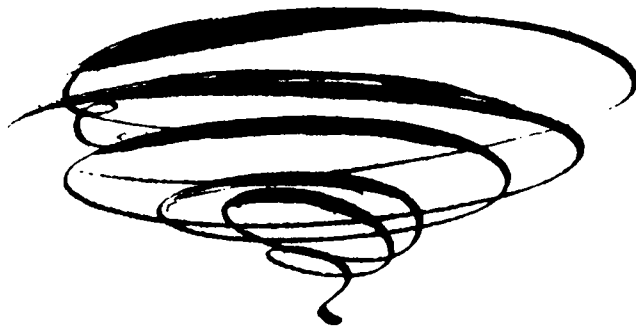

AN ACT. for the fourteen pence Tunnage.

WHEREAS by an Act of Assembly formerly
made Intituled an Act for Port Duties and Masters of
Ships amongst other things therein contained it was
Enacted that all vessels whatsoever not properly be-
longing to this Province having a Deck flush fore and
aft coming in and trading within this Province should pay
for Port Duties or anchorage halfe pound of Powder and three
pounds of shot or so much in value for every Tun of burthen
unto the Lord Proprietary and his heirs AND whereas
the said Act is altogether silent for what use the said
Imposition
