

By the present Generall Assembly, That an Annuall Certain  
allowance should be made to such persons who are app<sup>o</sup>  
and chosen to be of their Majesties Councill within this Pro-  
vince (except such as shall have and receive places of profit)  
Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and w<sup>th</sup>  
the advice and Consent aforesaid, That every person or  
persons nominated and appointed to be of their Majes<sup>ties</sup>  
Councill within this Province and having no such place  
of profit as aforesaid, shall for and in satisfaction of  
their cost and hire attending the Councill upon  
all occasions have and receive the Sum of thirty pounds  
Sterl. Ann<sup>o</sup>, the said Councillors to whom such allowance  
is made defraying their own expences without any  
charge to the Publick whatsoever And be it further  
Enacted by the authority aforesaid that the Sum of  
thirty pounds Sterl. to the person or persons so as a-  
foresaid due, shall be levied and paid out of the afores<sup>d</sup>  
Subsidy of fourteen pence  $\frac{1}{2}$  per Tun, and the remainder to  
go to the Supply of this Province with sufficient Provision  
of Arms and Ammunition any thing herein contained to  
the contrary notwithstanding. Provided allways  
and it is the true intent and meaning of this Act, that  
no Vessel or Vessels whatsoever properly belonging to  
this Province, coming in and Trading within this Province  
shall pay or be charged with any Port Duly or Anchor
