

Publick Affairs of the said County And be it further  
Enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every Justice of the  
Provinciall Court that hath no place of Profit within the Province  
shall be allowed out of the Publick Levy one hundred and eighty  
pounds of Tobacco yearly and no more for every day he shall  
serve during the said Courts besides his Itinerant Charges any Law  
Statute or useage to the contrary in any wise not withstanding.  
This act to endure for three years or to the End of the next Generall  
Assembly which shall first happen This act is to extend to all Counties  
in this Province Except Somerset County who is hereby allowed the  
sum of eight thousand pounds of Tobacco yearly it being at the  
Speciall request of the Representatives of the said County.
