

Differences and disturbances did arise and happen within this Province which occasioned many errors and irregularities in proceedings of Law and Equity, and in the Court for probate of wills to be committed for preventing of all disputes and troubles that may happen hereupon. **Be it Enacted** by the King and Queens most Excellent Majestys, by and with the advice and consent of this present General Assembly and the authority of the same, **That** all Bills Plaints and Process, Precepts, Pleas, Judgements, Indictments, Informations, Proceedings, Causes, Matters and things whatsoever commenced or depending in any of the said Courts since the first day of Aprill 1690, shall be good and effectual notwithstanding any errors therein contained by discontinuances or otherwise whatsoever, by reason of the said late troubles. **Provided** nevertheless that no person or persons whatsoever shall have or take any benefit of this Act for any error or mistake in any of the Processes, Pleas or other Proceedings not occasioned by the said late troubles, but that the same shall remain and be as if this Act had never been made any thing herein contained to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding. **And** for as much as by reason of the late Revolution all Judicall proceedings were impeaded and hindered for above two years last past viz^t from the year of Our Lord 1690 to this present time being the year of Our Lord 1692. **Be it Enacted and Ordained** by and with the advice and consent aforesaid and the authority of the same, that the said years shall not be accounted as years included & meant in the Statute of Limitations for payment or demand by debts due.
