Be it Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majestys, by and with the advice and consent of this present Gen.^l Assembly and the authority of the same, That all Bills Plaist & Proces, Precepts, Pleas, Judgements, Indictments, Informations, Proceedings, Councel, Matters and things what soever commenced or depending in any of the said Courts since the first day of Aprill 1690, Shall be good and effectuall notwithstanding any Errors therein contained by discontinuance or otherwise whatsoever, by reason of the said late Troubles Provided nevertheless that no person or persons what so ever shall have or take any benefit of this Act for any Error or Mistake in any of the Proceses, Pleas or other Proceedings not occasioned by the said late Troubles, But that the same shall remaine and be as if this Act had never been made any thing herein contained to the contrary hereof many wise notwithstanding And forasmuch as by reason of the late Revolution all Judiciall proceedings were impeded and hindered for above two years last past vix^t from the Year of Our Lord 1690 to this present time being the year of Our Lord 1692. Be it Enacted and Ordained by answ^r. The advice and consent aforesaid and the authority of the same, That the said years shall not be accounted as years included by meanes in the Statute of Limitations for payment or demand by debts due
