## An Act for settling Navall Officers Fees within this Province

Whereas for some Years past Masters of Ships and  
other Vessells trading into this Province have used to pay at  
the time of the clearing of such Ship or Vessell for each respective  
Clearing the sum of five pounds one Shilling and four pence  
under pretext of Secretaries Fees besides other Fees to sev<sup>l</sup>  
the Inferiour Officers for writing their Entries, Permits  
and clearings, which said Secretaries and other Officers Fees  
as aforesaid were not only Illegal and unreasonable but  
also
