and Loyall Subjects the Deligates and Burgeses of this present Generall
Assembly humbly pray that it may be Enacted And Be it Enacted by the
King and Queenis most Excellent Majesties by and with the advice
and consent of this present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the
Same, That from and after the Publication hereof, all Masters of Ships
and other Vessells importing Liquors into this Province with intent to
vend and dispose of the same, Pay unto their Majesties the sume of four
pence per Gallon for every Gallon of Liquor Imported into this Province
to the intent to vend and dispose thereof, the same to be Collected by
their Majesties Receiver Generall of this Province, who shall give
good Securify in their Majesties name to be accountable to the Assembly
and pay the same annually for the space of three years to the uses
afforeaid or any or so many of them as the said Generall Assembly
of this Province shall think fit to order and direct for the end
and purpose aforesaid CLONT be it further Enacted that every
Master at the time of affring such shipps or other Vessells aforesaid
shall render upon Oath an Account of the quantity & quality
of such Liquors so Imported to be vended or sold as aforesaid
and that the severall and respective Naval Officers within
this Province for the time being shall at the time of affring
