to be Agent for this their Majest^s Province
of Maryland.

Whereas it is thought necessary that an Agent be app^o
in London for this Province to defend and promote all things
for the good of this Province and also Mainlein all matters
that may come in debate or otherwise relate to the good and
wellfare of this Province, have unanimously voted and agreed
the said Peter Pagen to be our said Agent, therefore. Be it
Enacted by their Majesties by and with the advice and consent
of this present Generall Assembly, and it is hereby Enacted by
Autherity of the same, that the said Peter Pagen shall
be our agent for the end and purpose above sett forth and
declared, and that he the said Peter Pagen shall be paid
and satisfied such sum and sums of Money as he shall
from
