

An Act for limitation of certain
actions for avoiding suits at Law.

Forasmuch as nothing can be more essential to the
Peace and Tranquillity of this Province than quieting the
 Estates of the Inhabitants thereof and for the effecting whereof
 no better Measures can be taken then a limitation of time for
 the commencing such Actions as in the severall and respective
 Courts within this Province are brought from the time of the
 Cause of such Actions arising. Be it therefore enacted
 by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties by and
 with the Advice and Consent of this Generall Assembly &
 the Authority of the same, that all Actions of Trespass, quare
 clausum fregit, all Actions of Trespass delinie surmover
 or Replevin for taking away goods and chattels, all Actions
 of Account, contract debt Book and upon the case other
 then such Accounts as concern the Trade of Merchandise
 between Merchant and Merchant their factors & Servants
 which are not Resident within this Province, all Actions of
 Debt for Lending or Contract without Specially all Actions of
 Debt for arrearages of Rent, all Actions of assault, menace,
 Battery, wounding and Imprisonment or any of them w.
 shall be tried or brought by any person or persons within
 this Province at any time after the end of this present Gen.
 Assembly shall be commenced and sued within the time and
