absenting the Province ever rendering from County to County
until the time by the late Act for the reasons and purpose
aforesaid limited and allowed were required & bound having
benefit hereby and different Judgements given thereon in
the severall and respective Countys within this Province
for that the said Act was therein altogether silent ~
Be it therefore enacted by the authority aforesaid that
from and after the Publication hereof no person or
persons what so ever absenting themselves out of this Province
or that shall remove from County to County after any Debt
Contracted, whereby his Credit or Credit may be at any uncorstain
affectiong all the said Person or Persons or his or their Effects shall
have any benefit by i^e limitations & restrictions in this Act
Specified, Provided always and it is the true intent & meaning
hereof that this Act nor any thing herein contained shall be construed
reputed or taken to prejudice or debar any Person removing himself
& family from one County to another for his convenience or any other
leaving this Province for the term & time in this Act limited from
y^e benefit hereof, he leaving effects sufficient known for y^e paym^t
of his just debts in his hands & some provision wher
will affinately paym^t thereto to his Credit & anything in this Act contrary
to y^e contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding. June 9, 1692.
