Whereas divers the Inhabitants of this
Province have suffered much damage by the notorious
evil practices of ill disposed and malicious persons
burning their Fences, And whereas an Act of Assem-
bly Entituled and Act against Burners of Fences formerly
made, and from time to time continued hath been found
of great use and benefit to the Inhabitants aforesaid for
the abuses aforesaid. BE it Enacted by the King and
