

directly or indirectly take Exact demand or receive for the price
and pay for any such Liquor for which the Rates and prices
are as before said, shall for every such offence forfeit and
pay the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco one half thereof
to their Majesties, and the other to him or them that shall
informe and sue for the same, and also such debt so unjustly
charged exacted and demanded the said forfeiture to be recover-
ed in any Court of Record within this Province wherein no Stay or
Protection or wager of Law to be allowed. And every such
Ordinary keeper that shall demand exact or receive above
the sum of Ten pounds of Tobacco for small Beer,
twenty pounds of Tobacco for strong Beer, for a nights lodging
in a Bed four pounds of Tobacco, for a Beck of Indian shield
Corn or oats for a horse, twelve pounds of Tobacco for pasto-
rage for an horse for a Night six pounds of Tobacco, for hay or
Straw for an horse for a Night Ten pounds of Tobacco, shall
also pay and forfeit for every such offence the like sum of
five hundred pounds of Tobacco, one half thereof to their
said Majesties, and the other half to him or them that
shall informe or sue for the same, to be recovered as aforesaid
and also his debt so unjustly charged as aforesaid. And to
the intent that all Persons Inhabitant Travellers & Strangers
may be certain of sufficient Accommodation for them selves
and horses, That every Ordinary keeper or Inholder to be
Lycenced as aforesaid shall within six Months after grants
