

directly or indirectly take exact demand or receive for the price
and pay, for any such liquor for which the Rales and priors
granted as aforesaid, shall pay every such offence for feild and
pay the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco one half thereof
to their Majesties, and the other to him or them that shall
informe and sue for the same, and paye such debt so unjustly
charged exacted and demanded the said forfeiture to be recov-
ered by cause of record within this Province wherein no assygn
Protection or wager of Law to be allowed. And every such
Ordinary keeper that shall demand exact or received above
the sum of Ten pounds of Tobacco at a gallon for Small Beer;
Twenty pounds at a gallon for strong Beer; for a night lodging
in a Bed four pounds of Tobacco for a Peck of Indian sheld
Corn or cass for a horse. twelve pounds of Tobacco for pas-
sage for a horse & Night six pounds of Tobacco for hay or
Straw for a horse & Night Ten pounds of Tobacco; shall
also pay and forfeit for every such offence the like sum of
five hundred pounds of Tobacco, one halfe thereof to their
Sai Majesties, and the other halfe to him or them that
shall informe and sue for the same, to be recovered as aforesaid
and paye his debt so unjustly charged as aforesaid. And to
the intent that all Persons Inhabitants Travellers & strangers
may be certaine of sufficient Accommodation for them selves
and horses, That every Ordinary keeper or Inholder to be
Lycensed as aforesaid shall within Six Monthes after grant
