

weights, a quarter and a half quarter of a hundred a seven  
pound weight, four pounds weight, five pounds and one pound  
weight together with six stamps for the marking and stamp-  
ing of shillards and weights the said severall stamps to be mark-  
according to the directions of the above said Act and Cecil County  
to be marked with the letter K and also Craft measures of all  
and yard to be sealed in England, likewise a Sealed Bushell  
Peck and Gallon of Winchester Measure with a Gallon, Bottle-  
Pint, half pint of wine measure with three burnt stamps for  
the wooden Measures and three other stamps for the better mea-  
-sure, such Person or persons so appointed procuring the same or what  
is wanting to make good the severall standard aforesaid to be allowed  
and paid their charge and disbursements in the County Levy for  
the same. To which standard all persons whether Inhabitants  
or Forreign<sup>r</sup> are to repair and bring their shillards with which  
they receive their Tobacco yearly in every year to be stamped  
tryed and numbered, for which they are to pay to such Person  
keeping the standard aforesaid, five shillings for every time  
Such shillard shall be tryed and stamped as aforesaid, and every  
Person shall have their Barrells which are to contain five  
Bushells at least, together with their bushell half bushell,  
Peck, Gallon, Bottle, quart and Pint if they make use of the  
same or any of them in buying or selling by shall likewise  
have them tryed and stamped at the standard aforesaid for  
which they shall pay for the Barrell one shilling for all other  
measures
