

measures six pence a peice in the penalty of one thousand
pound of Tobacco to any person refusing or neglecting yearly
Tryings and Stampings of his Shillards as aforesaid and the sum
of five hundred pounds of Tobacco to any Person selling by any
the measures aforesaid refusing and neglecting to have them tryed
and Stampd as aforesaid, The one half of which forfeitures to be to
the use of the Poor of the Parish in which the said offender shall
dwell or render the other half to the Informer or Informers to be
Accorded in any Court of Record within this Province by Action
of debt bill plaint or Information wherein no Escoyn Protection
or wager of Law to be allowed And if any person or persons
shall refuse to pay any Tobacco by such Shillards tryed & Stampd
as aforesaid and shall thereby Compell the Owner of the same to
have them tryed over again within the year if the Shillards are
true, such person so refusing or compelling as aforesaid shall pay
for the trying of the same, but if not the owner of ^{say} Shillards
to pay for the same, And if any person or persons having the
keeping of such Standards as aforesaid, shall neglect or refuse
to supply the defects of the same as is before Express, & also
to provide a Standard where there is none such person so neglecting
and refusing shall be fined two thousand pounds of Tobacco by ^{the} use
aforesaid to be recovered as aforesaid.
