 quantity of four hundred pounds in Bulk that he or they
 shall so purchase as aforesaid, at the time of the delivery of such
 goods wares or Merchandizes for purchase of the said Tobacco
 as aforesaid, under the Penalty of the forfeiting of all such Goods
 wares and Merchandizes or Money sterl. to be paid in England
 which shall purchase such Tobacco as aforesaid, The one moiety
 of which forfeitures shall accede to Our Sovereign Lord & Lady
 the King and Queen their Heirs or Successors for supports of this
 Government, The other Moiety to him or them that shall for the
 same in any Court of Record within this Province, where in no
 Escoigne or wager of Law to be allowed This Act to endure for
 three years.
