person or persons shall Export or ship on board to the intent to Export
out of this Province either Woolle or Old Iron, shall for every of their
Offences in so doing pay as followeth (viz^t) for every pound of Woolle
fifty pounes of Tobacco, and for every pound of Iron Ten pounes
of Tobacco, the one half to their Majesties for Support of Government,
the other half to the Informer to be recovered in any Court of Record
within this Province by bill plaint or Information, this Act to endure
for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall
first happen
