

Generall Assembly having seriously considered the convenience  
hereby, concerning to the good people of this Province do pray that  
it may be enacted and be it enacted by the King and Queen most  
Excellent Majesties, by and with the advice and consent of their  
present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same, that from  
and after the publication hereof any person or persons what-  
soever that shall intend to depart this Province shall give notice at  
such place or places as he or she may by setting up his name at y<sup>e</sup> Secr<sup>r</sup> Office  
for the full space of three whole months, and half within  
that time no person shall underwrite the person respectively so  
setting up his name as aforesaid, it shall then be lawful for the  
Governor Chancellor or Secretary of this Province for the hindering  
of such person departing this Province to depart the Province, for  
which purpose the Party shall pay to the person signing the same,

granted by the authority aforesaid, That all Masters of Ships  
or Vessells or other persons whatsoever shall have Transport  
or Conveyance of this Province by Land or otherwise from

or Secretary of this Province for the hindering aforesaid, shall  
be liable to pay all such debts Engagements and damages to  
the person or persons to whom such debts and damages respectively  
shall be due within this Province, unless the same be otherwise  
adjusted in some convenient time, or within one Month he com-
