to the party grieved treble damages sustained, and shall also for-
feit the sum of six thousand pounds of Tobacco or forty pounds
sterl^d, the one moiety to Our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King
and Queen their heirs and Successors for the support of Govern^t
the other moiety to the party or parties that shall sue for the same,
wherein no Espeyne Protection or wager of Law to be allowed,
Provided all ways that if any Fees for any matter or thing —
hereafter to be done belonging to the severall Officers aforesaid
and by the Governour and Councill so allowed and adjudged &
not in this Act mentioned and limited and allowed and adjudged
It shall be lawful for such Officer or Officers to have such
Fee or fees as the said Governour and Councill for the time being
shall adjudge and allow of and no more under the penalty
aforesaid to be recovered as aforesaid, This Act to continue
for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly w^{ch}
