For the better settle<sup>m<sup>t</sup></sup> & limitation of the Clerks fees of y<sup>e</sup> severall  
 Courts <sup>in this Province</sup> for the future Be it enacted by the King  
 and Queens most Excell<sup>l</sup> Majestys by th<sup>er</sup> advise and consent  
 of this present Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly and the Authority of the same That  
 from hence forth no Clerks in any County Courts within this  
 Province, shall demand take exact or receive of any suitor  
 plaintiff or defendant or any other suitor or Petitioner or other  
 person what soever any other fees or reward for executing  
 of his Office of Clerk as aforesaid then are hereby limited  
 directed and allowed (that is to say) to Job.
