Clerk or Clerks ever within this Province shall by virtue
hereof either leave or cause to be carried away, Execution
upon the body Goods or Chattels of any person or persons
whatsoever for any Fees in this Act limited and contained
without first delivering or causing to be delivered a true and
just account of the Fees to them, one by this Act aforesaid -
under the hand or hands of such Clerk or Clerks to the Person
or persons from whom such Fees demanded are due, as
aforesaid, And in case the said County Clerks or any of
them shall act or do contrary either directly or indirectly
to this Act, he or they shall lose and forfeit to the High
Court of Admiralty, his damages sustained, and shall also for-
feit the sum of Three Thousand pounds Sterling or
hundred pounds Sterling for every time he or they shall do
the contrary, the one Moneys to our Sovereign Lord
and Lady, the King and Queen their Heirs & Successors,
for the Support of Government, the other Moneys
to the Party or Parties that shall inform, or sue for the
same, by Action of Debt Bill plaint or Information,
whereas no Stay, Protection, or waver of Laws be-
allowed. Provided also that if any Fees accrued for
matter or thing hereafter to be done, belonging to the said
Office of Clerk in the County Court aforesaid and
which they are not bound to do ex officio, and by the
Tutoris of the
County Court allowed also allowed to be done, and
