

Clerk whatsoever within this Province shall by Vertue  
 hereof either levy or cause to be levied any Execution  
 upon the Body Goods or Chattels of any person or person  
 whatsoever for any Fees in this Act limited and contained  
 without first delivering or causing to be delivered a true and  
 Just account of the Fees to them due by this Act as aforesaid  
 under the hand or hands of such Clerk or Clerks to the Person  
 or persons from whom such Fees demanded are due as  
 aforesaid, And in case the said County Clerks or any of  
 them shall Act or do contrary either directly or indirectly  
 to this Act, he or they shall lose and forfeit to the Party  
 grieved treble his damages sustained, and shall also for-  
 feit the sum of three thousand pounds of Silver or  
 twenty pounds of Gold for every time he or they shall do  
 the contrary, the one Moiety to Our Sovereign Lord  
 and Lady the King and Queen their Heir & Success<sup>ors</sup>  
 for the Support of Government the other Moiety  
 to the Parish or Parishes that shall inform or sue for the  
 same by Action of Debt bill plaint or Information,  
 wherein no Stayn Protection or waver of Law be-  
 allowed. Provided also that if any Fees accrued for  
 Matter or thing hereafter to be done belonging to the said  
 Office of Clerk in the County Courts as aforesaid and  
 which they are not bound to do *Ex Officio*, and by the  
 Justices of the  
 County Courts adjudged and allowed to be done, and
