*An Act for Amerciament in the
 Provinciaall and County Courts.*

Whereas many Suits are raised upon frivolous Occasions by
 Diligent persons, for prevention whereof for the future Be it
 Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties
 by and with the advice and Consent of His present Generall
 Assembly and the authority of the same. That all Persons
 what soever that are cast in any Cause, be they Plaintiff or
 Defencal, shall be Amerced besides the Damages & Costs
 to the Recoverers fifty pounds of Tobacco in the Province
 Courts And in the County Courts thirty pounds of Tobacco.
