

held after Michaelmas shall nominate and appoint some
 Justice of the Peace in every hundred or precinct who shall execute
 all precept and warrant therein directed and that all
 things have the like power within the said hundred and
 precinct as any Constable hath or ought to have in a hun-
 dred or precinct in England by the Law or Custome of En-
 gland, and the said Constable shall take the Oath mencioned
 in an Act made in the ^{first} year of their said Majesties' Reign, Entituled
 an Act for evbrogating of the Oaths of Supremacy & Allegiance
 and appointing other Oaths and also take the Oath in
 manner and form following, you shall swear you will well
 and truly serve our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King
 and Queen in the Office of a Constable, you shall see & cause
 that their Majesties' Peace be well and duly kept according
 to your Power, you shall arrest all such persons as in your
 presence shall commit or make any Riot or other
 breach of their Majesties' Peace, you shall do your best
 Endeavour upon Complaint to you made to apprehend
 all Felons Barretors Ryotters or persons riotously assembled
 And if any such Offendors shall make any resistance with
 force, you shall Levy Hue and Cry and pursue them untill
 they be taken, you shall do your best endeavour that Hue
 and Cry be duly raised and pursued against Murderers their
 and other Felons and fugitive Servants, And the Law and
 Orders against Vagabonds and such other idle persons con-
