

may be lawfull for the said Creditor to sue and Implead  
 such his Debtor for the said debt and recover against  
 him all such costs and damages as upon Legall Tryall  
 in any Court of this Province shall be adjudged against  
 him, and no person shall sue or implead any  
 such his Debtor as aforesaid contrary to this Act, he  
 shall loose all his costs of such suite and be liable to  
 satisfy such his Debtor all such damages as shall come  
 unto the said Debtor by such his vexatious & unjust  
 suited Law. Provided all ways that this Act nor  
 any thing herein conteyned shall be construed  
 extend to the benefit of any person Debtor as  
 aforesaid either maner way out of this Province  
 or wilfully absconding himself within the same  
 from his said Creditor, but that he may be pro-  
 ceeded against as before this Law made any  
 thing in this Act to the contrary notwithstanding ~
