Debts made or contracted before the end of the present
Session of Assembly, anything in this Act to the contrary
not withstanding. Provided and Be it enacted by the
Authority aforesaid That if any debt or debts shall or may
be payable or due from or to any person or persons -
debtor or creditor living or trading into this Province, under
one hundred three shillings and four pence or four hundred
pounds of Tobacco, that then and in such case it shall and
be intended and paid in any one particular commodity or
kind of Commodity or provision that is made current and rated
as aforesaid, and not in diverse the said particular kind
or commodity to be at Election of the person or debtor this
Act to endure for three years or to the end of the next
General Assembly which shall first happen ~
