

Record be kept of all proceedings that shall pass in the
 Lower house of Assembly in this Province. Be it there-
 fore Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent
 Majesty by and with the advice and consent of this
 present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same
 that the Clerk of the Assembly for the time being trans-
 cribe the said Journall within two Months after the
 dissolution or Prorogation of the said Assembly
 and deliver the same into the Secretarys Office up-
 on the penalty of five hundred pounds of Tobacco
 to Our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King & Queen
 for the Support of this Government and the loss of his
 Salary for his Service in the Assembly, the said fine &
 forfeiture to be levied upon the said Clerk by the
 appointing of the Gov. of this Province for the time being
 upon Certificate from y^e Secretary of this Province for the
 time being that the said Journall as afores^d is not by the
 Clerk of the Assembly delivered into the Secretarys
 Office afores^d. And it is hereby furth^r Enacted by the Au-
 thority aforesaid that the Secretary of this Province for the
 time being shall be enjoyned to examine y^e Secretarys Office touching
 y^e purpose of this Act, and make Certificate to y^e Gov. for y^e time
 being y^e hereby y^e fine & forfeiture afores^d may y^e more duly
 be paid
