

An Act for securing Creditors,

Whereas there are Prisoners in every County now
Guilh and force much as they were intended for the safe
keeping of Prison that Creditors might be secured to have
their debts paid after Judgment and Execution served,
and that Criminals might be brought to receive Punish-
ment Be it enacted by the King and Queen's most Excellent
Majesties by and with the Advice and Consent of their High-
Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same That
every Sheriff within His Province That shall have any
Prisoner committed to his charge in any Criminaall case
what so ever shall safe keep the said Prisoner until they be
delivered by due course of Law, and if any Sheriff shall
uffer any such Prisoners to escape voluntarily or neglig-
ently shall forfeit hundre thousand pounds of Tobacco,
the one half whereof to their Majesties for the support
of Government the other half to be employed in the
strengthening the Prison of the County and maintenance
of poor prisoners Be it further enacted by the Authority
aforesaid That when any person or persons are taken
by the severall and respective Sheriffs of the severall
and respective Countys in Execution for debt or upon the
mean process of severall & respective Sheriffs shall safely
be remanded to Prison by such means & in such manner as Prison
