Taxable person or persons in his or their family
shall for every such offence not given a true account
of them to the Constables when required, and every
person Taxable so by him concealed forfeit to pay
one thousand pounds of Tobacco for such Person
or persons so by him or them concealed, and every
Constable neglecting his office herein shall forfeit
peny the sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco
for every offence, such forfeitures and fines to be
levied by the Justices of the respective County Courts
for the use of the Poor of the Parish wherein
such Constables and Inhabitants do dwell and
reside and by them to be disposed of for the use a-
foresaid as the said Justices shall think fit
And to the end that no person for the future may
be ignorant what Persons are Taxables and
what not. Be it enacted by and with the advice
and consent aforesaid and the Authority of the
Same, That all Male Children born within
this Province and Resident in it shall be
taken and accepted Taxables at the Age
of fifteen years and upwards, and all male
Children servants Imported into this Province
at the age of fifteen years and upwards and
shall be accepted Taxables, And all Slaves
whatsoever.
