one hundred pounds for one year, and so after that rate
for a greater or lesser sum or for a longer or shorter
time, nor shall any person or persons what so ever in
this Province as aforesaid from and after the time fore-
said, take directly or indirectly for loan of any Tobac-
co wares Merchandizes or other Commodities for one year
to be paid in Tobacco or other Commodities of this Province
above the value of eight pounds of Tobacco for the forbear-
ance of one hundred pounds of Tobacco, and after that rate
for a greater or lesser sum or for a longer or shorter time
And that all bonds contracts and assurances what so ever
made after the time aforesaid for payment of any Principall
money or Tobacco Goods or Commodities aforesaid to be lent or
covenanted to be performed upon or for any usury whereupon
or whereby there shall be reserved or taken above the Rate
of six pounds in the hundred for money as aforesaid and above
eight pounds in the hundred for Tobacco or other goods or
Commodities as aforesaid shall be utterly void. And that all
and every person and persons what so ever which after the
time aforesaid shall upon any contract to be made take
accept and receive by waies or Meanes of any corrupt
bargain, Loan Exchange Cheifance Gift or Interest of any
wares Merchandizes or other thing or things what so ever or
by any deceitfull waies or means or by any Curious Engine
