sold Exchanged and shifted as aforesaid, The one half of the said
Fine and forfeiture to Our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King
and Queen their Heirs and Successors for the Support of this Gov-
-ment, the other half to him or them that shall sue for the same
to be recovered in any Court of Record of this Province by
Bill plaint or Information, wherein no Stayne Protection
or waiver of Law to be allowed.
