Be it enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties by and with the advice and consent of the present Generall Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That all Negroes and other slaves already imported or hereafter to be Imported into this Province, Shall serve their naturall lives and all the children born already or hereafter to be born et any Negroes or other slaves within this Province shall be slaves to all intents and purposes as their parents were, so the terme of their naturall lives C[on]cl forasmuch as diverse freeborn English and white women, sometimes by the Indiscretion procurement or concurrence of their Masters Mistresses, and alreadt to the satisfaction of their Execrable lustfull desires, and to the disgrace not only of the English but also of many other Christian nations, do sometimes intermarry with said womenes permitting themselves to be gotten with childe by Negroes or other slaves by which means diverse inconveniences Controversies and Suite may arise touching the issue of childe of such English or white women as aforesaid, For prevention of which inconveniences and others of like nature and equall evill Be it Enacted by and with the advice and consent aforesaid, That any freeborn Eng-
