other <sup>half</sup> to him or them that shall inform on any such  
to be recovered in any Court of Record within this Province  
by Bill, plaint or Information wherein no Office Protection  
or waiver of Law shall be allowed. And any Justice Minister  
Magistrate or other person what so ever within this Province  
that shall from and after the Publication hereof join in  
Marriage any Negro or other Slave to any English or other  
white woman servant free born as aforesaid, shall forfeit  
and pay the sum of Ten thousand pounds of Tobacco, one  
half to their said Majesties their heirs and Successors to the  
use aforesaid and the other half to the Informer to be recover-  
ed as aforesaid Any Law Statute or usage to the contrary not-  
withstanding.

this Province the Inhabitants do find themselves very much
