

He shall keep but one horse and the said horse to be a gelding
This Act to take place the last day of November next ~
And that the Fines and forfeitures in this Act mentioned
be to their Majesties for the support of Government, to be re-
covered by Action of Debt Bill plaint or Information where
no Office Protection or wager of Law to be allowed. This
Act to continue for three Years, And that no person whatso-
ever presume to Range in in the woods for wild Horses and other
wild Cattle without Licence first had and obtained from the
Governor for the time being under the penalty of fifty pounds
Sterl. for such default, and that no horse be Imported into
this Province upon penalty of forfeiting the same.
