 and reading by the last day of July in every Year  
 respectively, And when set up and finished not to  
 weigh above ninety pounds ~~wt.~~ <sup>Tolaunt for</sup> under the penalty  
 of one hundred pounds of every ~~lb.~~ that shall be  
 and after the Publication hereof hereafter be set  
 up of any other Timber that shall be so fallen and  
 beven or rived as aforesaid, or shall when set up or  
 finished exceed the Weight of Ninety pounds as afores.  
 to be paid by such Cooper or Coopers as shall be  
 set up or make any such Cask or Casks, to be received in  
 the County Courts where the Offence shall be committed  
 The one half to Our Sovereign Lord and Lady the  
 King and Queen their Heirs or Successors for the Support  
 of this Government. The other half to the Informer  
 or him or them that shall sue for the same as afores.  
 This Act to endure for three Years or to the end of  
 the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen.
