

and obliged to find themselves with yeas and sufficient  
 furniture for their Horses, and likewise to find them-  
 selves with swords, Carabines, Pistols, Halberds and  
 Ammunition, and if any Trooper shall neglect or refuse  
 to appear at Musters at the time and place appointed as aforesaid  
 upon notice given to them in Manner as aforesaid by  
 each respective Captain of Troop according to the Equipage  
 as aforesaid shall forfeit and pay the sume of one  
 hundred pounds of Tobacco to be Levied as aforesaid  
 for the use of the Troop for Trumpett and Colours  
 and other necessaries as the commander shall think  
 fitt, And that all such Troopers for any in con-  
 sideration aforesaid at all such times as they are out  
 ranging, shall find their own Provisions, but when in  
 Actual service then to be found Provisions at the charge  
 of His Province to be paid by the Publick, And if it  
 shall happen that any Trooper Horse be killed in the  
 Service, then the said Trooper to be paid for the said  
 Horse by the Publick and not otherwise.

ly. That all Persons in Holy orders, Delagates -  
 Magistrate and Constables shall with their proper Horses  
 be Exempted from being compelled to Muster and  
 Train either in Horse or Foot during such Termes as  
 they officiate or bear such Offices as aforesaid Pro-  
 vided that this Clause shall not extend to such Persons  
 as already have or hereafter shall accept of Com-
