

account of Merchandize with intent to Export the same out of this Province without leave and Licence from his Excellency the Cap^l Generall and Governor in cheife of this their Maj^{ties} Province and Territories, or from the Chief Governor for the being, under the pain and penalty of the loss of all such Skins & Furs so purchased as aforesaid, together with ten thousand pounds of Tobacco, to be forfeited and paid by the party or parties offending and Transgressing against the same, and thereof legally and ^{duty} convicted, one half thereof to their Majesties Heirs and Successors, and the other half to him or them that shall seize inform and sue for the same to be recovered by Action of Debt Bill plaint or Information in any Court of Record within this Province; wherein no Escoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allowed, this Act to endure for three years or to the end of the next Session of Assembly. &c.
