EIT ENACTED by the King and Queens molt Excollent Majolan's By and with the Advice and Confent of this present General Assembly and The Authority of the lame, That the Julices of Peaco in every County neche field County Court, beld after Michaelmas shall nominate and appoint some whattant an every Hundred or Precinct, who stall execute all Precepts or Walters to h directed, and shall in all things have the like power within the fair line and Precinct as any Constable hath or ought to have in a Hundred at the fair the fair than the England, by the Law or Cultom of England; and the faid Coultable and the Oath mentioned in an Act made in the first Year of their faid Majesty. Rough lots tulid an All for abrogating the Oaths of Supremacy and Allegiance in manner and focus You shall Swear you will well and truly Serve our Soverign Lord following. and Lady King William and Queen Mary in the Office of a Constable you shall fee and cause that their Majesty's Peace be well and duly kept according to your power, you shall arrest all such persons as in your presence shall commit any Rior, Fray, or other breach of their Majelly's Peace, you shall do your best endeavour upon complaine to you made to feize all Felons, Barretors, Riorers, or persons riotously aisembled, and if any such Offender shall make any Resistance. with Force, you shall Leavy Huo and Cry and pursue them until they be taken, you shall do your best endeayour that Hue and Cry be duly raised and pursued as gaink mucherers, whieves, and orly folons & flegitive forgation, & the Laws & Of ders gainst vagabonds & such other idle persons coming within your limits be du! ly put in execution, at your County Courts coming you hall present offences done against the several Acts made for the suppressing of Druskenness, and also true presentment make of all Bloodsheds, Afrays, Outeries, Rescues and of ther Offences committed against their Majesty's Peace within your Limits, your ther Otherces committee against their majerty's react within your Limits, your shall well and truly execute all Precepts and Warrants; to you directed from the Justice of Peace of this Country or higher Officer, you shall well and truly according to your knowledge power and ability execute all things be ionging to the Office of a Constable so long as you have in this Office, so help you God. And if the person so nominated to positive shall refuse to serve in the said Office by himself or his Deputy, or take the Oaths when tendered to him by the Julices of Peace as aforefaid, shall torfeit the fun of five hundred pounds of Tobacco, one morety thereof to their Majefly's their heirs and Successors, for and towards the Support of this Government, and the other moiety to the Church Wardons of the Parish in which he shall dwell or reside, to be recovered by Ball Plaint or Interpraction wherein no Effoyn Protection of Wager of Caw fuall be allowed, or fosfer ewo Months Imprisonment without Bail of Mainprize.

Be It Further Enected by the Authority aforefaid, by and with the Advice and Confent aforefaid, that all persons what soever that shall hereafter be nominated or appointed to be Justices of the Peace, Shereifs or Coroner within this Province, by his Excellency the Captain General or Governour in Chief for the time better, that resules to execute the Office of Justice of Peace Sherrif or Coroner within this Province, or to take the Oaths aforementioned in the Act of Parlianeur Morefaid made, and the Oaths of Justice of the Peace Sherrif or Coroner half soifest to our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King and Queen their Heirs and Successions 1000 Lobacco for the uses associated, to be respective.

And he is but ther finacted by the Authorny aferefaid, that whosever shall be Sammoned by Writ out of any Court of Justice of this Province to serve as a Juror in any Try at in any Court within this Province and resuse to serve in any Cause depending whether Criminal or Creat not being by any other Office exempted) and thereunto Lawfully required, shall sorieit to their said Majesty's cheir Heirs and innecessors the Sum of two his indred pounds of Tobacco for the uses aforesaid, to be recovered as aloresaid, or two Months Imprisonment without Bail or Main-payer.

And he is Further harded by the Authority aforefaid, that wholoever being by West Lawfally Susamoned and thereby required to serve as a Witness in this Fravence, and shall cofuse to tellise upon Oath in any case depending whether Caronal or Cook, shall feefelt to our Severeign Lord and Lady the King and
