BEIT FOR ENACTED by the King and Queens that Excellent Majelly's by and with the Advice and Confent of this present General Assembly and the Authority of the same, That if any persons whatforver from and after the publication, hereof shall unlawfully or compely procure any Witness or Witnesses by Letters, Rowards, Promites or by any other sinister uniawful Labour or Means whatforver, to commirany wilfuliand corrupt Perjury in any matter prequie whatloever now depending, or which hereafter shall depend in Suit and Variance by any Writt, Action, Hill, Complaint or Information in any wife touching or concerning any Lands Tenements Heredicaments or any Books, Chattele, Debt or Damages in any of the Coarts of Record within this Province, or that shall unlawfully and corruptly procure or suborn any Witness or Winesses from and after the publication aforesaid, to be Sworn to restific in perpetuam Rei Memoriam, that then every such Offender or Offenders heing thereof Lawfully Convicted or Attainted loofe and forfeit the Sum of fourty pounds Ster. ling, and if it happen any such Offender or Offenders being Convicted or attainted as aforesaid, thall not have Goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements to the value of fourty pounds as aforefaid, then every fuch person or persons so being Congreted or Arrainted as aforefaid, thall for his or their faid Offence suffer Imprisonment for and during the space of one whole Year without Bail or Mainpage, and Annaupon the l'illory for the space of one full Hourat the Pillory next adjoyning to the place where he sho arrivey shall be Convicted as aforesaid.
