Act. and County to be marked with the Letter K. and also Brass measure of Elland Ward to be Sealed in England, and likewise a Scaled Bushed, half Bushed, Peck, and Gallon of Winchester measure, with a Gallon, Pottle, Quart, Pinte and half a Prite of Wine measure, with three burnt Sramps for the wooden measures and three other Stamps for the Pewter measure, such person or persons so appointed, and procuring the same or what is wanting to make good the several Standards aforesaid, to be allowed and paid their charges and disburstments in the County Leavy for the fame, to which Standard all persons whether Inhabitants or Foreigners, are to repair and bring their Stilliards with which they receive 10bacco yearly, and in every year to be tryed stamped and numbred, for which they are to pay to such person keeping the Standard aforesaid two Shillings for every t ime fuch Stilliatds shall be tryed and stamped as aforesaid, and every person or persons shall have their Barrels which are so contain five Bushels at least, together with their Bushel, half Bushel, Peck, Gallon, Pottle, Quart and Pinte if they make use of the fame or any of them in buying or selling by, shall likewise have them tryed and flamped at the Standard aforefaid, for which they shall pay for the Barrel one Shilling, and for all other measures fix pence a piece, under the penalty of one thousand pounds of Tobacco to any person resuling or neg lecting the yearly trying and stamping of his Stilliar's as aforelaid, and the Sum of five hundred pounds of Tobacco to any perion felling by any of the measures aforesaid refuling or neglecting to have them tryed and stamped as afore taid, the one half of which Forseitures to be to the u e of the poor of the Parith in which the Offender shall dwell or reside, the other half to the informer or informers to be recovered in any Court of Record within this Province &c. And if any perion or persons shall refuse to pay any Tobacco by such Stilliards tryed and slamped as aforestaid, and shall thereby compel the Owner of the same to have them tryed over again within the year, if the Stillbards or true, fuch person so resulting or compelling as aforciaid, shall pay for the trying the fame, but if not the Owner of the Stilliards to pay for the same, and if any perion or perions having the keeping of - fuch Standard as aforesaid shall neglect or result to supply the desects of the same, as is before exprest, and also to provide a Standard where there is none, such perfons so neglecting and religing shall be fined two thousand pounds of Tobacco to the uses aforesaid, and be recovered as aforesaid &c.

An Ast against Excessive Usury.

Elt Enacted by the King & Queens most Excellent Majesty's by & with the Advice & confent of this prefent general Assembly & the Authority of the time, that no person or persons whatsoever within this Province, whether inhabit int or Foreigner, upon any contract, shall from & after the end of this profess of affembly, take exact directly or indirectly for Loane of any Mony, wares, Merchandizes or other Commodity's whattoever, to be paid in Mony above the value of Six Pounds for the forbearance of one Hundred Pounds for one Year, and to after that rate for a greater or leffer Sum, or for a longer or fivorter time, nor fitall any person or persons wharsoever within this Province as aforesaid, from and after the time aforefaid, take directly or indirectly for Loane of any Tobacco's Wares, Merchandizes or other Commodity's for one Year, to be paid in Tobacco, or other Comodity's of this Province, above the value of eight pounds of Tobacco for the forbearance of one hundred pounds of Tobacco, and after that rate for a greater or lesser Sum, or or a longer or shorter time. And that all Fonds, Contracts, and Affurances whatfoever made after the time aforefaid, for payment of any principal Mony or Tobacco, Goods or Commodity's aforefaid, to be lent or covenanted to be performed, upon or for any Uthry; whereupon, or wherehy
