ting shall think fit, unless such Commissioner or Commissioners make Laurist Excuse to be allowed of by the Court, and lorasmuch as it happens many trines in the Winter Season especially, that but two or three of the Commissioners do meet and attend upon the Days set and appointed as aforefaid, whereby all Process made Returnable that Court do fall and shate, and the several Plantis are sourced to Sue out new Writts to the great damage and delay of Suitors.

Be It Therefore Enacted by the Authority aforefald, that any the Carrier of the Commissioners, whereof one to be of the Quorum morting as hereby fully Authorized and Impowered to adjourn the Court to Identification after as to them shall feem meet, and that no Suit for want of a full Court doffell or abate, but the same shall be continued till the next Court, to be held according to such adjournment as asoresaid, and that if the fift Day appointed by this Act for the holding the several and respective Courts be not time enough to do the bufinels in that Court depending, then the Justices of such Court are hereby Impowered to adjourn from Day to Day until such time as the Dusiness returnable and cryable in that Court shall be finished, and whereas there bave some Seruples arifen by the Commissioners of the respective County Courts, whether they shall or may do any other bufiness in every June Court in every respective Year, then what was concerning Orthans, the true Intent and Meaning of this Act is, that the Commissioners of every respective County Court may and oughere do, hear gadge and determin any bufinels depending in the faid Court, at the fame June Court between any persons whatsoever, as well as relating to any Orphana Basi Liness.

An All for the publication of Marriages,

E IT ENACTED by the King and Queens nioft Excellent Majesty's by and with the Advice and Confert of this present General Assembly and the Authority of the same, That all persons who shall desire Marriage shall apply themselves either to a Minister, Paltor or Magistrate for the contracting thereof.

And Be It further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, that all perfors within this Province inconding Marriage, flull make publication thereof either at the Church, Chapel, County Court or Meeting House next where they dwell, and that at fuch time when fach Church, Chapel or Meeting House shall be full, and chereby capable to take cognizance thereof, and that it shall and may be Lawful upon such Conificate had from the Minister, Paster or County Court when such application shall have been made, of three Wocks after the said publication, for eicher Minister, Pastor ot Magistrate to join in Marriage such persons aforesaid; and if any person thall presume to contract Marriage without such publication Muste and Cerunicate Checamillad's aforesaid, or without particular Licence from the Governour for the time being, do privatly within the Limits of this Province contract Marriage, every perion fo contracted or married half be lyable to a Fine of one thousand pounds of Tobacco, and every such Minister, Pastor or Magnifrate joyning in Marriage any persons without fuch publication or Lieence se may ways infringing this Act, firell be lyable to a Fine of five thousand pounds of Tobacco, the one half of the faid lines to our Lord and Lady the King and Queen their Heirs and Successers for the Support of Government, and the other half to the informer, to be recovered by Bill Plaint Action of Debt or Information in any Court of Record, wherein no Lifeyn Protedion or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And Be li further Enacted, that all fuch Matriages as shall not be made before some Muniter, Paster or Magistrate with five sufficient Witnesses at least, according to the some aforementioned, shall and are hereby declared null and void.

And the It further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, that all Ministers Pallors and Magistraces, who according to the Law of this Province do usually joyn pearlie in Marriage, Ibali joyn them in much er and form as is fer down & expect in the Lieurgy of the Church of England, which being finished, the Minister, Pastor of Magistrate shall fay. (I being how two by Law Authorized do pronounce you have full Managis Wife)
