

Touching Coopers &c.

within this Province, wherein no Essoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And Be It Further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid, that no Tobacco Hogshead or Cask for Tobacco shall be set up or made by any Cooper or Coopers whatsoever of any other Timber then what is herein before provided, and the same to be hewed and staves and heading by the last Day of July in every Year respectively, Cooper, Coopers or other persons undertaking to set up such Tobacco as aforesaid, do at the compleating and finishing of the said Hogshead or respective House, burn in the Bulge of each respective Hogshead by the aforesaid with a brand Iron the two first Letters of his Name, and every Head by him so branded to weigh, and the true weight thereof with marking Irons to cut into the Bulge aforesaid, on penalty & forfeiture of the Loss of his Labour for every Cask or Hogshead not branded as aforesaid to the Employer of such Cooper, as also the Sum of one hundred pounds of Tobacco for every Hogshead by him falsely weighed or marked as aforesaid, one half thereof to our Sovereign Lord and Lady the King and Queen their Heirs and Successors for the use aforesaid, the other half to him or them that shall sue for the same to be recovered as aforesaid.

Provided that this Act nor any thing therein contained shall be construed or taken to prejudice any Cooper or Coopers, or other person or persons from undertaking to set up Tobacco Hogsheads as aforesaid for any Error or Mistake in the weight of each respective Hogshead by him so weighed and marked as aforesaid, not exceeding five pounds weight in the Hogshead; and that all and every person and persons whatsoever that shall undertake to make his or their own Cask, shall and are hereby obliged to brand, mark and weigh every respective Hogshead by him so made, under the same penalty and forfeiture as is before mentioned and expressed.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, by & with the Advice & Consent aforesaid, that every Master or other Owner of any Servants or Negroes, & that shall employ any Servant or Negro to set up his her or their Cask or Tobacco Hogsheads, such Master or other Owner shall be obliged to fall, saw, hew, and let up such his Tobacco Hogsheads within the several and respective times by this Law is before limited and appointed; and them when finished to brand mark and weigh under the same penalties and forfeitures as is before provided against Coopers and other persons undertaking to set up Tobacco Hogsheads as aforesaid. In consideration of all which, the Receiver of any Hogshead of Tobacco shall pay and allow to the Owner or Owners thereof for each Hogshead Received the Sum of forty pounds of Tobacco, deducting out of the gross Weight the true Weight of each Hogshead marked on the Bulge aforesaid and no more, any other Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

An Act for Confirmation of all Proceedings Judicial Military and Civil, from the death of his Excellency Lynel Copley Esq; their Majestys late Governor and Capt: General of Maryland &c. unto the Arrival of his Excellency Francis Nicholson Esq; the present Governeur thereof.

AN ACT BE IT RULAS upon the death of Lynel Copley Esq; late Governeur of Maryland, Sir Edmund Andry Esq; Knight Governeur of Virginia, in their Majesties Names did affirme and take upon him the Government and Chief Command of this Province, by virtue of a Commission from their Majestys, bearing date the third Day of March anno Domini 1693. in the fourth Year of their Majestys Reign under their Signet and Sign Manual, wheron and whereby their Majestys Names are plenteed by these Presents to constitute and appoint the said Sir Edmund Andry upon the Death of Capt: Francis Nicholson, and in the absence of the said Lynel Copley, and no otherwise, to be Commander in chief in and over this Province, and by virtue thereof the said Sir Edmund Andry in their Majestys Names by his Proclamation bearing date the 25th day of September 1693. in the fifth Year of their Majestys Reign, Reciting that whereas by the death of the said Lynel Copley their Majestys late Capt: General and Governeur in Chief in and over the said Province of Maryland, and the absence of Capt: Francis Nicholson
