An All probibiting the inhabitants of this Province or any others from carring Liquors to the Indian Towns;

EITENACTED by the Kings most-Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of this present General Assembly and the Authority of the same, that from & after the publication hereof any person or persons white soever inhabiting or tracing into this Province, that shall presumer o carry any liquors whatloever to any Indian Fort or Town, or within three miles of such Fors. or Town, and shall vend or dispose of the same to any Indian or Indians what soever, such person or persons shall forseit the sum of sive thousand pounds of the co, one half thereof tour Sovereign Lord the King his Heirs and Successors to-wards the Support Covernment, the other half to him or them that shall in-form or sue for the case, to be recovered in any Court of Record within this Province, wherein no gloyn Protection or wager of Law to be allowed.

An Alt for Summoning grand and petty Juries.

HEREAS by Law it appears to be the indubitable Right and Property of the Kings Majesty's Subjects throughout all his Majesty's Dominions all cases, either meum and tuum or Criminal matters to be tried by their equipes that is a grand and petry Jury. And for that the constitution of this his And for that the constitution of this his Mejetys Province will not admit of fuch ways and methods as is practifed in the Kingdom of England by reason of the small number of inhabitants, & divers other

impediments not to be avoided.

BEIT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of this present General Assembly and the Authority of the same, that the chief Clerk of the Provincial Court shall issue out several Writts of venire factas for two good, and lawful Men Freeholders to serve upon a grand Jury for the Body of this Province, and several other the like Writts of vexire facias for three like good and lawful Men to ferve upon perty Juries, which Writes of Summons thall be directed to the high Sherrifs of each re-Countys in this Province, by vertue of which hid Writts the said Sherrifs shall 20 days at least before the Provincial Court at which the faid Jurors shall serve summons and give notice to the faid party and partys, that rhey be and appear as by the Writts of Sumons shall be directed, (Indices of the Peace and Delegates allways excepted) and for default hereof, the Sherrif to offending shall forfeit and pay a Fine of one thousand pounds of tobacco, and each party so summoned and refuling to serve and not appearing at the time and place appointed shall forfeir and pay a fine of five hundred pounds of tobacco, and if it so happen by casualty or by accident that there shall not appear a sufficient number for a grand Jury legally fummoned, then the number to be made good and compleated by the high Sherrif attending the faid Court of other persons by standers of the same County if any be present, but if none present, of the next adjacent County legally qualified to serve as aforefaid, and upon refusal they shall be subject to the like fines as aforesaid, & for fuch their service & attendant e of the grand Jury at each Court they shall have an allowance of three thousand pounds of tobacco our of the publick Revenue of this Province towards the de fraying of their charges and expences.

And it is hereby further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that the high Sherrifs of each and every respective County is this Province are hereby authorized & impowered to fummon a fufficient number of Freeholders, good & lawful Men to ferve on a grand Jury in the County Courts of this Province twice wearly at the least, that is to say at March and Nevember Court, and oftner if need require, at the discretion of the Justices of the said Countys, and to summon the said grand Jurous at least ten days before each Court, for which Service the Justices of each respective County Court shall and are hereby impowered to make such reasonable Allowance as to them shall feem meet, not exceeding the furz of four hundred pounds of robacco each court & the faid Secrifs neglecting their office & duty herein as aforefaid, shall for every such offencetorseit andpay the sum of five hundred pounds of robacco, and the party or partys fo refusing to serve when legally summoned shall forfeit and pay the sum of two hundred and sifty pounds of tobacco.
